Students are reminded to be careful when walking to and from school, especially on Riffington. Please use the sidewalk and do not walk down the middle of the road. We have had a few close calls and we want to keep everyone safe!

Student Parking! Many students are not parking in proper designated student parking spots (student lot or dirt lot). We will start **towing** students who continue to park in areas that are not designated student parking areas. Students will be responsible for all towing charges.

<u>Student Parking Areas</u> - Students are reminded that they must have a MBSS Student Parking Pass registered with MBSS and will need to park in Student Parking areas (The student parking area by the gym, the student area by the fence line towards the Tennis/Pickleball courts, or the dirt lot past Jim Lind Arena.) All students with motorized transportation, including EBikes, EScooters and Motorbikes must register their mode of transport with the school. Students may not park in Staff Assigned Spaces, in Visitor Parking, or in the back of the school. Students who park in areas other than ones designated for student parking may be towed.

To our MBSS Community - Student Pick Up and Drop Off:

For the safety of our students, if you are picking up your child, please arrange for pickup from an alternate location. This will ease congestion around our school. Also, please note that the sidewalk area, beside the portables, is reserved for SCHOOL BUS PICK UP/DROP OFF ONLY! Please see below for 3 suggested areas to pick up or drop off students:

- 1. Royal Lepage/Jim Lind Arena
- 2. Riffington Place
- 3. Boucherie Ball Fields (along East Boundary Road)

Reminder to be respectful of our neighboring strata developments and others in the community (ie. not parking in designated handicap spots, etc). Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
