Students must complete at least 1 course of Indigenous content for graduation. This could be in grade 10, 11, on 12.

## Grade 10: $\quad 8$ courses inside timetable NO SPARES

Grade 11: 8 courses inside timetable NO SPARES
Grade 12: $\quad 6 / 8$ courses inside timetable
3 course minimum per semester
Outside the timetable (OTT) courses counted separately

Online courses are 'extra' and are not part of timetable course count. You will not get a spare if you choose an online course.
