

Mount Boucherie Secondary Safety Update

Welcome Back, everyone!

With the increased spread in the COVID virus, we have had to change and enhance some of our safety protocols. Please remember that our goal is to try to make Mount Boucherie as safe as possible for all of our staff and students.

Some of our expectations have been in place for awhile, but now, we need to be more vigilant, and all of us need to be following these expectations on a more regular basis.

Before coming to school, everyone must perform a daily health check:

Daily Health Check

Please stay at home if you are not feeling well. Please have a parent contact the school.

You must wear a mask in all common areas, (Hallways, Career Centre, Library, MPR), and in your classes. You must also wear a mask on the school bus and upon entering the school.

(It is more safe to wear a mask at all times, even outside, at MBSS.)

Wearing a mask is for your safety, and the safety of others.



**Students and staff must immediately wash their hands upon entering the building.
This should occur after breaks and lunch, as well.

Wearing a mask can help keep you and others safe. Studies have shown that the chance of catching coronavirus drops dramatically if all parties wear a mask.

When you come into the school:

1. Please wash your hands (please try to make sure that there are not too many students in the washroom at the same time) and then:

2. You must go to your classroom

3. The Cave & Global Village Café will be open, but students will not be allowed to eat or drink in the hallways

2. You will not be allowed to sit in the hallways or loiter/congregate in any common spaces (MPR/Foyer etc.) or at the front of the school

We have gone back to staggered breaks

All grades in all classes will start at 9am, and all students will be dismissed at 3:19pm. However, this time, grade 11 & 12 classes get to have their breaks first.

Lunches will also have different start and end times. Hopefully, this will decrease congestion in our hallways.

This will be our schedule until the end of the semester:

Break (10 Min) **Grade 11 & 12** 10:10am, **Grade 10** 10:20am, **Grade 9** 10:30am

Start (2nd Block) **Grade 11 & 12** 10:20am, **Grade 10** 10:30am, **Grade 9** 10:40am

Lunch **Grade 11 & 12** 11:40 – 12:15pm
 Grade 10 11:50 – 12:25pm
 Grade 9 Noon - 12:35pm

Start (3rd Block) **Grade 11 & 12** 2:20pm, **Grade 10** 2:30pm , **Grade 9** 12:40pm

Break (10 Min) **Grade 11 & 12** 1:40pm, **Grade 10** 1:50pm **Grade 9** 2:00pm

Start (4th Block) **Grade 11 & 12** 1:50pm **Grade 10** 2:00pm **Grade 9** 2:10pm

All Breaks are only 10 minutes long!

That means:

Students must be back in class within 10 minutes. In mixed grade classes, teachers will determine when the 10 minute break is for the entire class. Students who are late may not get their breaks the next day.

Please remember that breaks are determined by the teacher.

At break:

During breaks, students can stay in class, go outside, or use the washroom and then return to class.

Students will not be allowed to congregate in common areas or the hallways, or at the front of any school entrances. As well, social distancing must be respected, at all times.

At Lunch, students must:

- a.) leave the school site immediately**
- b.) go outside for the entire lunch period**
- c.) go and eat lunch in their afternoon classroom**

We Understand:

That all of these extra precautions are a “pain in the butt.”

We have been asked by the Provincial Health Authority to enhance our safety protocols to ensure that our school is a more safe place to be.

Let’s try to keep everyone as safe as possible.
