

NEIGHBOURHOOD RELATIONS

It is important that MBS maintains a good relationship with the residents and others in the area. The school expectations are that we keep our neighborhood clean and be friendly and considerate to our neighbors. They deserve to see the best in you. The expectation is that students not to gather or loiter in areas outside the school grounds, including side streets and wooded areas close to parking lots, mountainside, and along the stream area in the immediate community. Do not trespass, drop garbage or cause disruption on the property of any of our neighbors. Smoking, vaping, etc is permitted only in our designated smoking area and not in our school community, side streets, parking lots, and community areas. These areas are all part of the "School Environs" and under the school act the school is under the obligation to monitor and supervise these areas during the school day. The school day is understood to be from the time a student leaves their house until such time as the student returns to their home. MBS students may not trespass on other schools and their grounds unless you obtain permission from their office immediately upon arrival.
