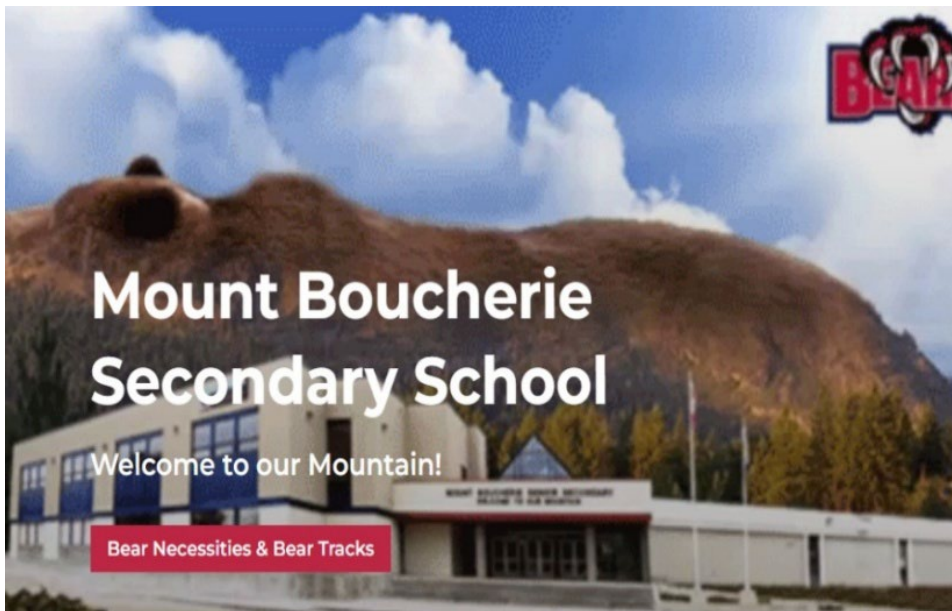
Please remind your Grade 12 students to return their overdue Textbooks/Library books to the MBSS library by Fri June 19.
